Porsche racing with four nations. Most exciting one-make series in the region. That is what drives the organization and partners behind the Porsche Sprint Challenge NEZ.



As a driver in the Porsche Sprint Challenge NEZ, you are instantly climbing onto the Porsche Motorsport Pyramid. Our championship provides the stepping stone to develop and ultimately graduate on the Porsche Motorsport Pyramid to high level international championships. In 2023 Valters Zviedris, champion of PSCNEZ, received wild card entry to the global Porsche Junior Shootout. One of the 12 Juniors will receive a position in Carrera Cup level for 2024, but all will now have their names familiar at top level racing teams.

Three Porsche Trophies, seventeen Porsche Sprint Challenges and eleven Porsche Carrera Cups operate worldwide, culminating with the internationally contested Porsche Mobil 1 Supercup. This is the world's fastest international one-make championship, and it tours selected rounds of the Formula 1[®] Championship.

The Porsche One-Make series is one of the most successful international racing programmes and Project European Winter Season is the perfect way to further a racing career for every type of driver. Through direct involvement in the European motorsport and together with Porsche AG we continue to raise customer awareness and interest in Porsche Motorsport throughout the Europe to unprecedented levels.

Porsche Sprint Challenge North European Zone

Porsche Sprint Challenge NEZ offers a full season of Porsche Motorsport racing in 2024. Races are organised as a part of Porsche Sports Cup Weekend events together with the Porsche importers in the region and Baltic Touring Car Championship, presenting you all the racing categories. The series is developed according to the feedback from the teams and drivers. The racing schedule, a selection demanding tracks, and regulations to support the racing action have all been detailed to provide the best racing in the NEZ region. Series organization is trained and supported by Porsche Motorsport.

Racing is fair and committed to follow the Porsche Motorsport rules of racing. The latest generation of the 911 GT3 Cup is of course proudly displayed in our series, but Porsche Approved Cup provides a competitive environment for the previous generation as well.

The Porsche Sprint Challenge NEZ is run as a national championship. Each event has two races with rolling start. This makes the series is the ideal option for drivers to gain experience and prepare them for the application of an international racing licence. Furthermore, the separation of drivers in different classes depending on car type and driver level makes sure that every driver on the grid has the chance to be proud of their place on the podium!



Entry

Entry fee for the season

The registration & entry fee is until 31th January 5,000 € (VAT 0%)* until 15th of March 6,000 € (VAT 0%)*

Series registering will open in the Series website January 2024.

The Series registry will be copied as an Entry for every Event.

Possible cancellation must be submitted according to the AKK / Series regulations.

Entry fee per event

Registration to a single Event must be done separately.

The Guest Entry fee per car is 1,200 € (VAT 0%)


- *Prices do not include the value added tax as effective by law, if applicable. The entry fee per car includes the following services:

- 1 set of stickers and competition numbers


A single entry fee is to be paid directly to PRCF Events Oy.

The payment is not a confirmation of acceptance of the "Application" for Team Entry".

Junior Program

Porsche Sprint Challenge NEZ Junior Program is part of the Series official young driver's development program.

The participation is voluntary and is made through the Driver registry.

To be eligible for participation in the program and to receive full support, the driver must


- be 23 years or younger when applying
- be enrolled for the full season
- take part in every event and at all races at these Events (excl. technical reason)
- participate in all events Series promoter requires
- ensure peak physical and medical condition
- cannot be a member of the Porsche Motorsport Junior Programme


Junior Program slots will be allocated on a first come first serve basis.

All Competitors and Drivers participating in this programme must agree to provide access to the Cosworth data for data analysis and evaluation as required by the Junior Programme support personnel after each session. The Series Organiser ensures that the provided data will only be used for the specified purpose and no data and / or graphical analysis will be distributed to or shared with other Drivers or teams.

All Junior Program driver/s has the opportunity to get the number of tyres as stipulated in the contract with the Series tyre supplier during the racing season. If the participant fails to take part in all Events, he will be automatically suspended from the program, and are no longer entitled to program support and the tyres delivered so far will be invoiced from the entrant.







Catering & Tire Service

Team Catering

The Porsche Team Catering is available at all events of the Porsche Sprint Challenge NEZ 2024. Within the Porsche Hospitality breakfast, lunch and dinner are offered in buffet form. The teams and drivers can choose the food to their liking.

The service times are scheduled according to the respective event schedule and announced via the team information App. With each entered car, the team receives three catering packages. Additional catering packages can be ordered up to one week before the event.

Tire Regulations and Service

Michelin is the official tire supplier.

Test day and free practice: no limit on new tire sets.

Qualifying and Race: two new tire sets in first

Event, one set per event after that Jokes Tires; only

Qualifying and Race: two new tire sets in first Event, one set per event after that. Joker Tires: only allowed in case of tire damage, time penalty ensues.

Michelin has developed a tire exclusively for the Porsche one-make series. These tires can only be obtained by entered teams. Michelin's tire service is available at every event, providing comprehensive customer service.
